Child support is based on three factors, your gross monthly income, the gross monthly income of the other party and the percentage of time the other party spends with the child or children. The court uses a program that calculates that amount. However, the parties can agree on any amount that they choose to use as long as it is agreeable with both parties the court will agree with it. If the parties are not agreeable then a court hearing will be required so that the court can obtain the information to calculate the child support numbers.

Are you seeking spousal support? _____

Spousal support is based on length of time of the marriage and the ability of the other party to pay. Because we are only a document preparation service we are unable to provide you with the information regarding spousal support. If you are seeking spousal support and you do not have an agreement with the other party you will need to seek legal advice as to your rights regarding spousal support. The court will require a hearing to determine the information necessary to make an order for spousal support.

Community property includes anything that the two of you have acquired since the date of marriage and includes everything from vehicles, residence, furniture and furnishings, bank accounts, retirements, pensions, 401(k)'s, life insurance, stocks, etc. It is very important to make sure that all the property is listed to protect both parties. If you do not have an agreement a court hearing will be required so that the court can make an order dividing the community property pursuant to the family code.
